Purpose: A clear, factual guide for representing Torium Network professionally, responsibly and confidently.

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1. Executive Overview

Torium Network presents itself as an enterprise-oriented Layer-1 blockchain combining mobile participation through its Proof of Participation (PoP) model with enterprise-focused verification and supply-chain use cases. The project is designed around the idea that a smartphone can provide a low-barrier way for people to participate in blockchain activity without specialized mining hardware.

According to Torium's May 2026 whitepaper, the project is currently progressing from testnet development toward an incentivized testnet in Q4 2026 and a planned mainnet/TGE phase in 2027. Roadmap dates can change, so ambassadors should always distinguish between current functionality and future plans.

2. How Torium Works

Proof of Participation (PoP): Torium says its consensus/reward approach emphasizes participation, time and consistency rather than expensive hardware or large token holdings.

Mobile-first participation: Users interact through the Torium mobile application and mining sessions. The project's stated goal is to make participation accessible using ordinary smartphones.

Testnet: Torium has described testnet infrastructure including an explorer, wallet functionality and peer-to-peer transfers. Testnet activity should not be described as equivalent to live mainnet transactions.

3. Token & Ecosystem Direction

Area	Torium's stated direction
Mining	Mobile participation/reward model using PoP
Utility	Payments, airtime/data, gift cards and ecosystem services
Marketplace	P2P transfers and marketplace activity
Enterprise	Product verification, tracking and supply-chain services
Governance	Progressive decentralization with future DAO direction
Mainnet	Planned for 2027, subject to development and other conditions

4. Ambassador Role

Torium's official Ambassador Program describes ambassadors as community bridges responsible for content creation, education, community building and other verified contributions. The program is performance-based and includes a seven-day onboarding track, profile setup, content tasks and review.

Current program information lists reward streams including monthly TOR rewards through points exchange, view-indexed scoring, USDT prize pools and qualifying per-post USDT rewards. The program states that rewards require verification and that fake engagement, bought views or manipulated evidence can result in loss of eligibility.

5. Seven-Day Professional Action Plan

Day	Professional objective
Day 1	Learn the product fundamentals, join the ambassador workspace, prepare public profile links and clearly understand what is live v
Day 2	Choose 2–3 genuine content angles: PoP/mobile participation, testnet development, and future utility/enterprise use cases.

Day 3	Publish your first educational content and save every public link for verification.
Day 4	Engage with community questions and create conversation rather than only promotional posts.
Day 5	Create a clear explainer thread, carousel or short video about one real Torium feature or workflow.
Day 6	Remix your strongest topic into a fresh format and distribute it naturally.
Day 7	Prepare a clean proof pack containing links, screenshots, notes and your strongest content for review.

6. Ambassador Communication Standard

Be factual: Never present a roadmap item as an already-launched product.

Be transparent: State clearly when something is planned, under development or on testnet.

Do not promise profits: TOR's future value and exchange availability should never be guaranteed.

Do not fabricate: Avoid fake testimonials, fake partnerships, manipulated screenshots or artificial engagement.

Educate first: Your strongest long-term value is helping people understand the technology and ecosystem.

7. Key Talking Points

- Torium is building a Layer-1 blockchain around Proof of Participation.
- The project aims to make blockchain participation accessible through smartphones.
- Torium is developing testnet infrastructure before mainnet.
- Its stated long-term direction includes consumer utility and enterprise verification.
- The current public roadmap targets mainnet/TGE in 2027.
- Ambassador activity is designed around measurable contribution, content quality and verified reach.
